1. Prior to understanding the truths taught in this passage, how would you have answered the question, "Who is Jesus?"
2. Why is it important to turn to the Bible to understand who Jesus is?
3. In what ways does the culture around us misunderstand who Jesus is?
4. Colossians 1:16 shows that all things were created by, through, and for Jesus. In what areas do you struggle to trust that Jesus is over all creation?
5. How does the knowledge of Christ's sovereignty over creation encourage us when we are worried about issues related to government? Why is it important to labor for the glory of God over earthly political movements?

6. In the midst of suffering, have you ever wondered where God was? How did you face that battle? How does this text encourage you for the next time you are in the midst of those battles?
7. Colossians 1:23 shows us what it looks like to continue, or endure, in the faith. How have you previously misunderstood what it means to endure in your faith?
8. How does this passage challenge and encourage you to hold fast to Christ and his gospel?
9. What are practical ways that we at CEFC can encourage and help one another to hold fast to the gospel?
