II. 7 Lessons for Christians

1. God is in control (Ex. 8:22; Jer. 10:10)
2. Eternal things cannot be destroyed (Mark 8:36-37; Luke 16:11)
3. Human trials increase our dependence upon God (2nd Cor. 12:9; 2nd Tim. 4:17)
4. Christian fellowship increases in trials (1st Thess. 4:9)
5. Christians desire heavens' perfection sooner (Rom. 8:18; Phil 3:20)
6. Christians are strengthened during trials (2nd Cor. 1:4)
7. Christians give God more glory (1st Pet. 4:16, 19; Psalm 16:8-9)

III. 7 Lessons for Non-Christians

1. Life is fragile (Psalm 39:5; Job 8:9)
2. You are limited by your humanness (1st Thess. 5:3)
3. We all die—even you (Psalm 89:48; Ecc. 8:8; Heb. 9:27)
4. Our world is totally fallen (Rom. 5:12; Deut. 28:19)
5. This is just a foretaste of worse to come (Luke 21:11; Rev. 6:12)
6. God is calling you to repent NOW! (Luke 13:1-2)
7. Time is running out fast (Luke 13:6-9)
